CONFERENCE INVITATION

Dear Colleagues,

We are delighted to welcome you to participate in the Third International Conference AFTER COMMUNISM. EAST AND WEST UNDER SCRUTINY in Craiova, Romania, 5-6 April 2013. More than two decades after, an event is both history and present. More than twenty years after the fall of communism is still a good moment for learning what happened, by combining common and scientific knowledge. It is still possible to directly contact those involved on both sides of the barricade, and the idea of searching for the public opinion of the moment is not totally unrealistic.

The distance in time allows a certain emotional detachment and favours a more objective, fact-oriented analysis. Moreover, there is the possibility of accessing some documents, until recently classified or hidden. It would prove hazardous to hope that we could totally solve what happened within Eastern Europe during 1989, but we can try to clarify a series of peculiar aspects and to create an intermediary synthesis which would serve as basis for future researches.

We dear to state that we even bear the moral obligation to do that.
