

The many faces of $OSp(1/32)$ ¹

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ABSTRACT

Here we give several properties of real and complex $OSp(1/32)$ algebras and relate F-, M- and type II-string theories through representing the same $OSp(1/32)$ superalgebra in different bases. These theories are shown to be connected to each other via dimensional reduction and T-dualities.
