
Filologia modernă: realizări și perspective în context european, ediția a VIII-a, Chișinău, 16-17 octombrie 2014, coordonator Viorica Răileanu, Institutul de Filologie al Academiei de Științe a Moldovei, "Elan Poligraf", 2016, 272 p. (Simona Sandu Pîrvulescu)

The 8th edition of the National Colloquium with International Participation Modern Philology: Achievements and Perspectives in European Context, organized by the Institute of Philology of the Academy of Sciences of Moldova, took place on 16-17 October, 2014. The general topic Current issues of linguistic and literary research brought together 71 researchers and teachers from the Republic of Moldova and Romania.

The proceedings of the colloquium were grouped into five sections: *Dumitru Matcovschi - poet, prose writer, playwright, publicist and Bessarabian academician; Literary criticism and theory; Criticism and literary history; Romanian language; Theoretical and applied research in terminology and onomastics.* 

This volume, coordinated by doctor Viorica Răileanu, assoc. prof. and researcher, a volume that came out in Chişinău in 2016, under



the aegis of the Institute of Philology of the Academy of Sciences of Moldova, contains 41 articles covering the five sections of the colloquium.

The pride of being Romanian is justified while reading the articles in this volume, because some of the authors prove a special interest in approaching the works of Mihai Eminescu, Mircea Eliade, Constantin Noica: in the opening article dedicated to Dumitru Matcovschi, Eminescu's spirit is everywhere, enlivening the pages of the article *Dumitru Matcovschi in a poetic dialogue with the founder of Romanian spirituality* (author: Dumitru Apetrei), the author also reminding the Mircești bard.

Linguistic variation, including the dialectological aspect, is dealt with in the following articles: *Morphological particularities of the Moldovan languages in the northern area in the Romanian general context* (author: Stela Spînu); *The relationship of linguistic geography to etymology and statistics* (author: Vasile Pavel); *Phonetic features in Alexandria* (Rom. ms. copied in *Chişinău* in 1790) (author: Galaction Verebceanu).

Within the section *Theoretical and applied research in terminology and onomastics*, the article *Economic terminology. Interdisciplinary adjectival elements and common language elements* (author: Silvia Pitiriciu) caught our attention. As the title indicates, the author pays special attention to interdisciplinary adjectives in specialized languages.

The importance of the volume resides in the richness of information and the variety of sources that indicate the profound, thorough research of the themes presented in each article.
